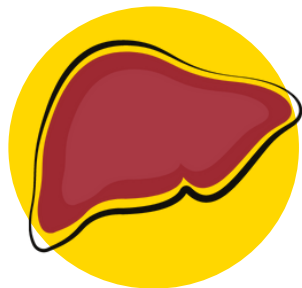


# Hepatitis B Vaccination: What You Need to Know

is cancer prevention!**

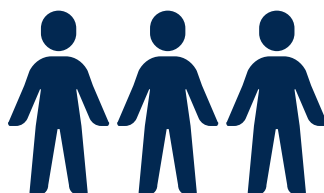


Hepatitis B is a vaccine-preventable liver infection caused by the Hepatitis B virus (HBV).

Without treatment

**1 in 4**

people with Hep B  
develop serious  
liver problems



A common mode of HBV  
transmission is from  
mother to baby.



Without HBV vaccination  
at birth, newborns are **90%**  
more likely to develop a  
chronic HBV infection  
throughout their lives

## When to Vaccinate



3 Doses



**For adults ages 18-59 that did not  
receive the vaccine as a baby...**

**2, 3, or 4 Doses**

**The CDC suggests that all adults aged 18 and above should get tested  
for HBV. This includes people who have never been screened for HBV  
and those who don't have a long-term HBV diagnosis.**
