2. **Question:** Based on constructability review, we have identified several concerns regarding the electrical and equipment schedules, particularly around dedicated power requirements and phasing impacts. Please provide clarification on the following items:

 - Circuit is rerouted in Phase 1 (Make Ready), then demo'd and repurposed in Phase 2.
 - Can Phase 2 work be completed during Phase 1 to reduce wall openings and minimize MOPs?
 - Refer to Sheets: E2.02 and E2.07.
2. **Room 0711C – CPU and Printer Power**
 - No dedicated power shown per Q4.01 requirements.
 - E2.02 shows wall molding with multiple outlets only.
 - Please confirm if dedicated power will be provided.
3. **Rooms 0711A and 0711B – CPU Power**
 - No dedicated power shown per Q4.02 requirements.
 - E2.03 (NGLA1) does not indicate dedicated circuits.

- Please confirm.
- 4. **Room 0776 – CPU and Printer Power**
 - No dedicated power shown per Q4.02 requirements.
 - E2.04 (NGLA3-6) shows multiple outlets only.
 - Please confirm.
- 5. **Room 0762 – CPU Circuits NGLA3-2 and NGLA3-4**
 - Please confirm these are separate circuits and qualify as dedicated per Q4.03.
 - Refer to Sheets: E2.06 and Q4.03.
- 6. **New CPU and Printer – Q10.00**
 - No plan sheet attached.
 - Please confirm dedicated power is provided.
- 7. **New Pyxis – Q10.00**
 - No plan sheet attached.
 - Please confirm dedicated power is provided.
- 8. **New Refrigerators REF-2247, 2247E, and 2741 – Q10.00**
 - No plan sheet attached.
 - Please confirm dedicated power is provided.

6. **Question:** Issue: It has been identified that the Hazardous Material Report, which is referenced in Section 01 56 20, was attached under Section 01 56 10 in the HCAI stamped set. This discrepancy may cause confusion for bidders and subcontractors regarding the correct location of the report. Request: Please confirm the Hazardous Material Report will be moved to Section 01 56 20 to align with the noted reference.

Answer: Revisions have been applied to ITEM NO. II _ SPECIFICATIONS in this Addendum and will be provided as part of a future NMA.

7. **Question:** Sheet A2.02A - demo note 2.65 calls for Drywall to be demolished per the demo drawings and per the remodel drawing, it is being replaced with fortress wall panels. Please confirm the intent is to demo all existing drywall in this space and replace with new drywall prior to fortress panels being installed. Please confirm the existing drywall will not remain behind new fortress wall panels.

Answer: Demolition and Remodel notes for Fortress Wall System and gyp board have been reconciled during ACD001. See Sheet A2.02A. Notes D2.65 and D2.66 designate walls for demo of existing gyp board and where existing gyp board is to remain.

8. **Question:** Please confirm if the twenty-one (21) day University's Representative review of submittals and twenty-eight (28) day Fire Marshal review of submittals are concurrent.

Answer: Spec Section 01 33 00 1.03A, please revise University Representative, UCDH PO&M, Fire Marshal review duration to 14 days in lieu of 21 days. Yes, all 3 reviews will be concurrent.

9. **Question:** Please confirm the use of Badger No-Drill Metal Deck hangers are acceptable on this project.

Answer: We have reviewed the request to use the Badger No-Drill Deck Hangers. The request was not clear what the intended use is for the proposed Hanger. The Badger No-Drill Hangers are not currently in the project. Please use the approved plans for the attachments to the deck or provide more info on the intended use in the future.

10. **Question:** Please provide HAZMAT reports for all potential hazardous materials within the work area.

Answer: See Spec Section 01 56 10 attachments. Note that this will be relocated to Spec Section 01 56 20 in a future NMA.

11. **Question:** Sheet note #3 on pages T2.03-T2.06 states 'Demolish all existing cables that are not current CAT-6A standard back to telecom rooms, and remove patch panel.' Please confirm this note applies only to existing cables tagged for demo and relocation. Existing data which is left in place and outside of the scope boundary is exempt from this statement.

Answer: Response will be picked up in Addendum 3.

- 12. Question:** Numbered note 4 states 'Floor data shall be removed. Pull out (E) cabling and abandon (E) conduit in place.' Please confirm floor box data to be removed is being demoed back to the designated telecommunication room or coiled overhead for future.

Answer: For bidding purposes, assume this cabling to be removed back to Main Tele Room 0709 (see T1.01) and remove from patch panel. See also T2.03 Sheet Note 3.

- 13. Question:** The finish schedule on I-1.00 shows WC1 Wall Covering, however this wall finish type is not shown on the finish floor plans. Please confirm this note is not applicable, and that Wall Covering is not being used on this project.

- 14. Question:** The finish schedule on I-1.00 shows EP1 Epoxy Flooring, however this flooring type is not shown on the finish floor plans. Please confirm this note is not applicable, and that Epoxy Flooring is not being used on this project.

- 15. Question:** The finish schedule on I-1.00 shows DP1 Decorative Paneling, however this finish type is not found in the plans. Please confirm this note is not applicable, and that Decorative Paneling is not being used on this project.

- 16. Question:** The General Finish Notes on I-1.00 notes 'float & skim walls to be Level 5 Drywall Finish UON. Float & skim (E) walls as required to match existing & to receive new wall base.' However the Drywall Spec 09250-3.02C.4 notes that walls are to be Level 4 Finish. Please confirm what level finish the walls and gypboard ceilings shall receive.

- 17. Question:** Please inform which (if any) Emergency Power electrical panels will require energized work because they cannot be shut down.

21. **Question:** Please confirm that there will be no staging/laydown space and that all deliveries are required to be 'just in time'.

Answer: Confirmed. No staging/laydown space. All deliveries are required to be 'just in time'.

22. **Question:** Mechanical overall plan M2.00 and MP2.00 does not match up with phasing sheets. Please confirm that we are to bid off of phasing sheets for all scopes.

23. **Question:** Plans call out for a new CAV (CAV-0.67) in area that CAV-0.15 is being demolished (see 28 and 30/M2.02B). This does not match up with details on MP2.02B. Mechanical detail 1/MP2.02B shows the demo of the piping, however detail 20/MP2.02B does not show any new piping or the CAV. Please clarify as this specified new CAV-0.67 has a reheat coil.

- 24. Question:** Can the existing fiber and or copper backbone support the current and future bandwidth demands for added devices in the work zone?

- 25. Question:** Please confirm whether paging speakers are OFOI, OFCI or CFCI? If contractor furnished, please provide make and model.

Answer: Paging speakers for this project are Contractor Furnished, Contractor Installed (CFCI). All IP speakers are to be used are ALGO model 8198-IC. Additional Note: Please submit detailed shop drawings for approval prior to the start of construction, showing speaker locations and mounting methods to ensure compliance with design intent and Division 27 standards.

- 26. Question:** Will patch cords be OFOI?

Answer: Network patch cables will be OFOI. Patch cables at the WAP and camera locations will for OFCI. UCDH IT will perform patching in Tele Room racks.

- 27. Question:** Will DMP be an acceptable alternative to the Bosch intrusion panel?
