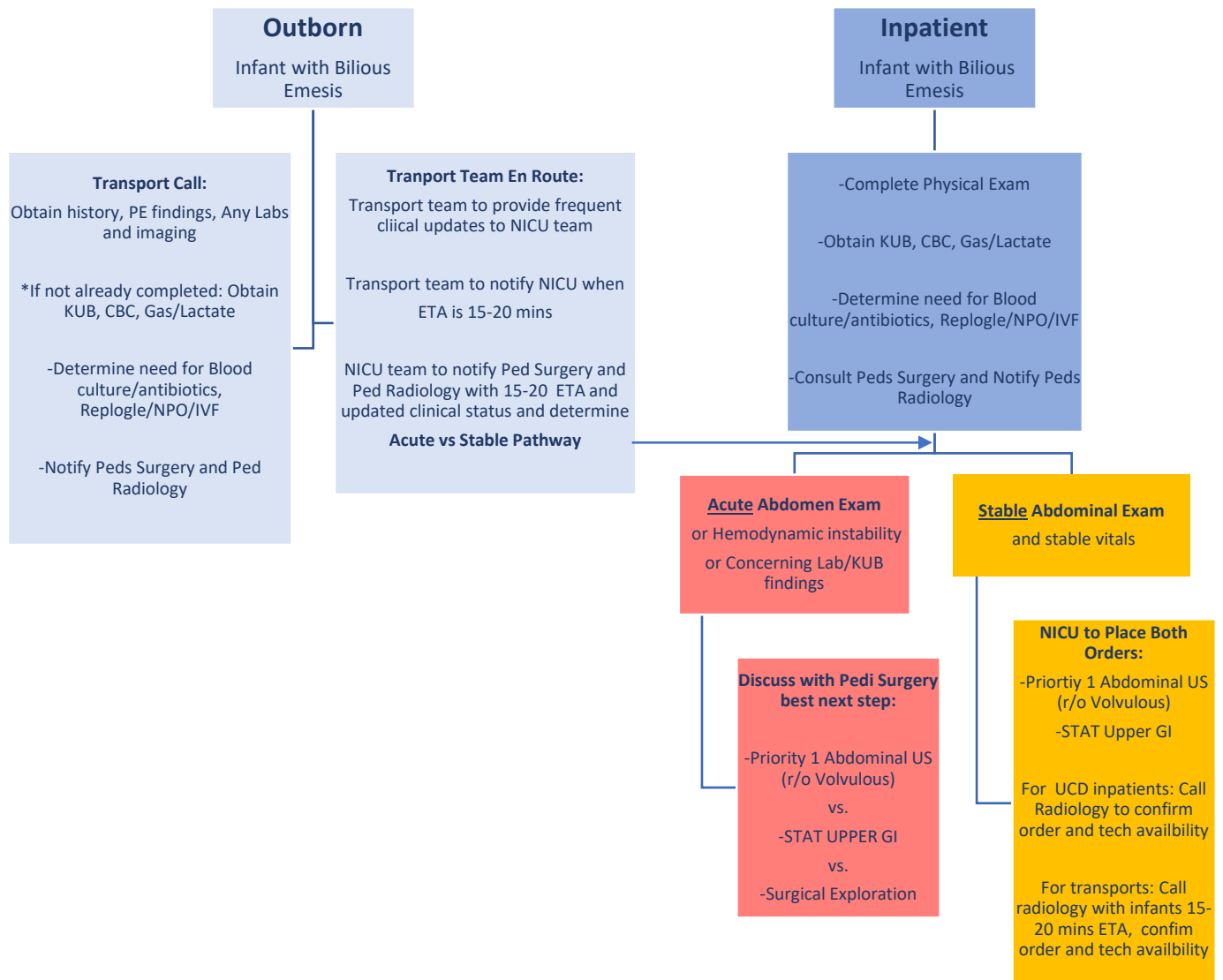


Evaluation of Bilious Emesis in a Neonate
